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Revised Volunteer Hours for the 2017-2018 school year

The service hours serve two purposes. First and foremost, volunteer hours help raise needed funds for the school. Also, when parents work together for the common good of the school, a greater sense of community is created.

We have heard from several parents regarding the required service hours for the 2017-2018 school year. It is not our intent to create a burden for our families. As a result, we have revised your commitment for service hours for the next school year.

The Home and School Association raises money to help defray the cost of running the school as tuition does not cover the full cost of the operational budget. This money is raised through the various fund raisers held throughout the school year.

For the next school year each family will be asked to provide 15 service hours throughout the next school year.

The buyout for families not able to meet that commitment will be \$360.00 for the year or \$24.00 for each hour.

If you have returned your Family Tuition Agreement and have checked off paying the \$600.00 buyout, that will be reduced to \$360.00.

If you checked off committing to the 25 hours, that will be reduced to 15 hours.

You do not need to sign another agreement. If you have returned your agreement, please understand that we will honor the commitment of hours or the buyout that is in this memo.

If you have not returned the agreement, your may write in the amounts as listed above.

We wish to offer our sincere gratitude to the volunteers who have worked tirelessly throughout this school year to support the various events and fundraisers that are a great support to our school.

For the next school year, it is our plan to offer several social events throughout the school year for you and your children to enjoy.
